- *Dinnertimes - more activities - We have introduced a Key Worker at Lunchtime who works with Year 5 children to run activities for the other classes. We also have a range of equipment and games out daily for the children to play with. Each day there is a teacher on dinner duty and this includes them being outside during the playtime after dinner, to encourage the children to be more active at dinner times. The School Council are working with Mrs Langton to vary the school meals.*
- *Some bad behaviour in school - The school runs a strict Behaviour Policy, linked to our Great Expectation rules. Any children not following rules or making the wrong choices are dealt with effectively by staff and if incidences continue to occur a member of the senior leadership team become involved. - *Better link between church and school - School has received an 'Outstanding' grade in our recent SIAMS (Church Inspection). We link closely with the Church/Clergy and have a strong Christian ethos running throughout school.*
- *Too much homework - Homework is set following the Department of Education guidelines and is given to enhance your children's learning and also prepare them for the workload at Secondary school.*
