A packed lunch will be provided for the trip on Tuesday. Please ensure full school uniform is worn.

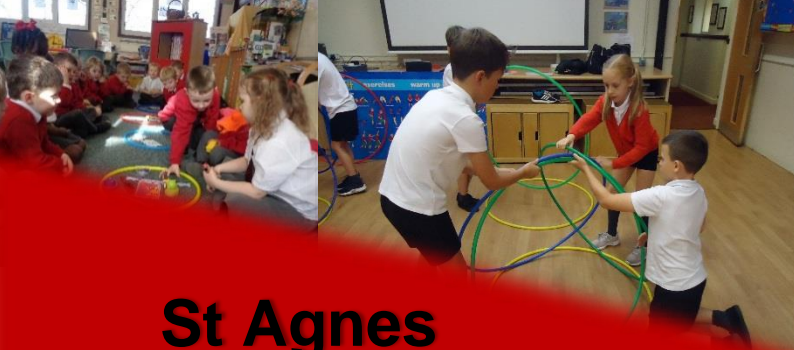
