Free School Meals and Universal School Meals

Please note there is a difference between free school meals and universal school meal. Universal school meals are free lunches for all children in Class 1 and 2 and parents do not need to apply for this. Free school meals are for families in receipt of certain benefits and can be applied for at www.oldham.gov.uk/fsm. Parents/Carers do not need to apply for free school meals if they are in receipt of Housing Benefit or Council Tax reduction. If you receive free school meals the school will be given extra funding to support your child. Parents with children in Classes 1 and 2 **must** still apply to ensure the school gets the additional funding. Each sibling must be claimed for separately.
