Free school meals are for families in receipt of certain benefits and can be applied for at [www.oldham.gov.uk/fsm](http://www.oldham.gov.uk/fsm) Parents/Carers do not need to apply if they are in receipt of Housing Benefit or Council Tax Reduction. If you receive free school meals the school will be given extra funding to support your child. Parents with children in Classes 1 and 2 **MUST** still apply to ensure the school gets additional funding and each sibling must be claimed for separately. Please speak to Mrs Bayley in the office if you need any help with this.
